The Combined Degree Advantage

Combined degree programs provide international students the opportunity to earn a second degree at a top-ranked university after completing their bachelor's degree at Drew. By studying a combined degree program, students diversify their experience and strengthen their abilities to find employment opportunities. Drew students participating in combined degree programs have access to specialized advising to ensure that they are on track to complete the requirements.

What Makes A Program "Combined Degree"?

Drew University is committed to ensuring that combined degree programs are accessible to international students. Dual degree programs for international students should always include:

- Guaranteed progression; Drew programs always include clear academic guidelines.
- No requirements for SAT or ACT scores to transfer into a combined degree program
- Accessibility after enrollment. At Drew, there is never a need to qualify for a combined degree program before beginning undergraduate study.

Columbia University: Engineering

This program leads to an undergraduate liberal arts (BA) degree from Drew and an undergraduate engineering (BS) degree from Columbia (No. 4 *US News* National University). Students enter Columbia after their junior or senior year at Drew. Program graduates are "liberally educated engineers," possessing strong communication and problem-solving skills. This is the only guaranteed entry program offered by Columbia School of Engineering.

Wake Forest University: Business Management

This program leads to a BA from Drew and a Master of Arts in Management from Wake Forest (No. 27 *US News* National University). This 10-month graduate business degree is available to all non-business majors at Drew. International graduates of this program have a 93% rate of sponsorship for H-1B Work Visas in the US. Guaranteed scholarships are available to students who meet minimum GPA requirements.

Stevens Institute of Technology: Software Engineering

This program leads to a BA from Drew and a MA in Software Engineering from Stevens (No. 75 *US News* National University). Computer science majors or minors complete their undergraduate degree at Drew and go on for a year or year and a half at Stevens to earn their master's degree. Stevens ranks third in universities for Best Career Placement by *Princeton Review* and eighth in average starting salaries after graduation according to PayScale.
